MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN Department of Economics, Guru Nanak Khalsa College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), Matunga, Mumbai AND Mumbai Sustainability Centre

Shiromani Gurdwara Prabandhak Committee's Guru Nanak Khalsa College of Arts, Science & Commerce (Autonomous), having its institution situated at Matunga, Mumbai # 400 019, constituted under the Sikh Gurudwara Act, 1925 acting through its Head, Department of Economics, hereinafter for brevity's sake referred to and described as the "Khalsa College", (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors in interest, authorized officers, representatives and assigns) of the One Part

the Mumbai Sustainability Centre ("MSC"), a Section 8 company registered under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 bearing registration number CIN-U74999MH2016NPL286836, Dated 17th October, 2016 and bearing CSR Registration Number CSR00010638 with registered office at 24/303 Park View, Oshiwara MHADA, Andheri West, Mumbai - 400053 (Maharashtra State) acting through Mr. Rishi Aggarwal its Director and Constituted Attorney, hereinafter referred to as MSC or jointly "Parties", on 10th Day of August, 2024. In consideration of the mutual understandings and covenants set forth herein, the Parties agree as follows:

Both parties are engaged in social welfare activities. Khalsa College is an education institution of repute affiliated to University of Mumbai engaged in providing various educational courses. MSC runs a project called 'Walking Project' for which both the parties are partnering for a short duration.

AND WHEREAS both the parties are desirous of partnering for projects specifically 'Walking Project'.

1. SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

- The New Educational Policy (NEP) mandates that students should undertake a A. mandatory Community Enhancement Programme for 30 hours.
- The Second-year Economics major students (hereafter referred to as students) Β. of DoE-GNKC will accordingly work along with 'Walking Project' to undertake an audit.
- As part of the association, the 'Walking Project' will hold one or two offline C. sessions to provide orientation to the students about the basics of Indian Road Congress (IRC) guidelines on pedestrian infrastructure, the audit, recording and reporting procedures.
- The 'Walking Project' team will be available for online consultation. D.
- No financial consideration is involved in the project work on the part of both E. the parties.

2. TERMS

2.1 Duration

This MOU shall be effective for a period of THREE MONTHS starting from 10th AUGUST 2024 till 9th NOVEMBER, 2024.

2.2 Responsibilities

- MSC shall provide the audit template and IRC guidelines. 2.2.1
- their audit shall evaluate the students on based **GNKC** DoE. 2.2.2 report/presentation/viva voce, carrying 20 marks.
- MSC shall evaluate the students based on the log-book records, punctuality and 2.2.3 overall performance for 30 marks.

Any further changes/amendments to the terms and conditions of this MOU shall

- 2.2.4 be done in writing by mutual agreement between both the Parties.
- The Parties agree that this is a non-profitable venture for a social cause. 2.2.5
