

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai

And

College of Social Work (Autonomous), Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai

This Agreement is made on the 20th day of July, 2022 between Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), as the first party and College of Social Work (Autonomous), Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai as the second party.

PURPOSE

Whereas

Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) is desirous to train volunteers in social service as discussed in the purview of this MoU,

&

College of Social Work (Autonomous), Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai is willing to offer an **Appreciation Course for Volunteers– Level 1** as discussed in the Purview of this MoU.

That, relying on the principle of good faith, by virtue of which they will carry out all the possible actions for their due fulfillment, and relying also on their common bonds and concerns, they state their interest in strengthening their relationships through academic cooperation, and for this end they are of one accord in entering this MoU.

NOW THEREFORE THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS

1. OBJECTIVE:

The parties agree that the objective of the present MoU is to train volunteers through Appreciation Course for Volunteers– Level 1 (a program of the College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai).

2. FUNDING:

a) There shall be TWO batches (90 students) of Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) who will be trained as per the Appreciation Course for Volunteers– Level 1 curriculum designed and delivered by College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan,

Mumbai

- b) Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) shall be responsible for cost associated with the TRAINING VENUE & FOOD expenses if any; and students are responsible for their own travel expenses during the training
- c) The training fee of Rs 90,000 (1,000 per student) shall be deposited by Guru Nanak Khalsa College in the bank account of College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai.
- d) No other fees or expenses will be borne by either of the parties

3. TERM:

This MOU shall be effective for academic year 2022-2023, and shall be renewed if both the parties agree to continue with the partnership.

4. CONFLICT RESOLUTION:

Any dispute resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through direct negotiation and **common agreement** by the persons delegated to such end by each Institution.

And since both parties are in agreement regarding the content of the present document, and as a token of conformity, we sign it in two counterparts, both of which will be considered originals.
