Co-Curricular Courses: The CC courses designed for the SY students who have not enrolled in any of the allied services in Semester III: NCC, NSS, Sports and Leo club. Students enrolled in these allied services will earn 2 credits after completing a 30-hour course, including an evaluation of 50 marks. Those students who have not enrolled in the allied services are entitled to complete CC courses offered by the committee. It is centralized across all streams.

3. Pre-requisites for the CC courses:

- Accept the Google classroom invite and join the classroom immediately.
- Save the name as: FIRST NAME ROLL NO. CLASS NAME (CS/IT/BMS etc.)
- Maintain decorum on online and offline mode
- Any form of misconduct during online sessions will not be tolerated and disciplinary action will be taken by the committee.
- The requirements for the activities shared by the resource person in the classroom should be followed strictly.
- All activities will be evaluated and attendance is mandatory for all the sessions.

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- 4. **Evaluation Criteria**: All courses (Co-Curricular / Allied Services) are planned for 30 hours and will be evaluated for 50 marks distributed as follows:
 - Internal Assessment: 30 marks, which will be based on projects, assignments, group-based activities, etc.
 - External Examination: 20 marks, which will be assessed through MCQs via Google Forms.

5. Attendance and Credit Eligibility:

- A student who completes the 30-hour course in Allied Services / CC courses in each semester is eligible for the 2 credits in the respective semester.
- If a student successfully completes the participation in Allied Services only in Semester 3, they will be eligible for 2 credits for semester 3. Further, if the student does not complete the participation in Sem 4, then the student will not be eligible for any credits in that semester.
- It is mandatory for students to complete a 30-hour course, either through Allied Services or the CC course through CC committee.
- **6. Failure in Evaluation**: If a student fails the evaluation of a CC course, they must submit a project or assignment worth 50 marks to earn the credit. The decision for the same will be taken by the committee.
