Therefore, ENPL and Department of Nutraceuticals recognized that mutual collaboration, given each other's strength in research and facilities thereof, will mutually benefit the students of the department of Nutraceuticals and ENPL industry personnel.

Now therefore, the parties hereto have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of understanding (MOU) considering the long-term benefits of sharing the knowledge between Department of Nutraceuticals and ENPL to establish a vibrant Industry and academic collaboration, by undertaking joint activities in their respective fields of research. As below (hereinafter referred to as "Activities")

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I: SCOPE OF THE MOU

The general purpose of this MOU is to facilitate industry and research cooperation between the parties hereunder based upon the principles of mutual benefit and may include the following general cooperation areas.

- 1. The projects will be jointly carried out at ENPL and Department of Nutraceuticals at its laboratories depending upon the requirements and infrastructure facilities.
- 2. The collaborative research work for projects will be decided with mutual discussion and consent of ENPL and Department of Nutraceuticals.
- 3. ENPL and Department of Nutraceuticals will mutually advise and support in planning and executing programs promoting excellence in respective areas of research.
- 4. Department of Nutraceuticals will provide guidance for the purpose of conducting collaborative research project.
- ENPL will provide guidance of industry experts for the purpose of conducting collaborative research projects as required.
- 6. ENPL will allow the use of infrastructure, consumables and equipment for research work.

- 7. ENPL will allow the exchange of scholarly information including research papers, databases and bioinformatics software. Share the library and scientific literature facilities mutually by giving access to library and other resources of ENPL to students of Nutraceuticals.
- 8. There will be an exchange of scientific expertise between ENPL and the Department of Nutraceuticals.
- 9. ENPL will allow the students of Nutraceuticals for internship training in R&D, QA/QC, and relative ongoing projects.
- 10. The Department of Nutraceuticals will provide potential innovative/novel product ideas/ finished products in said categories of ENPL; ENPL will guide the students of Nutraceuticals with specific modifications that are suitable for commercial release.

ARTICLE II DATA OWNERSHIP

- 1. ENPL shall have exclusive ownership rights to the Research Data, as well as to the content of analyses and reports relating to the Research which are delivered to the Department of Nutraceuticals by ENPL. ENPL shall be free to use the Research Data and the content of such analyses and reports for its own business purposes. Department of Nutraceuticals agrees not to reproduce and/or disseminate such Research data and the content of such analyses and reports for its benefit or the benefit of any third party.
- 2. All rights in respect of the Intellectual Property of the Research projects are proprietary to ENPL and the Department of Nutraceuticals agrees not to reproduce and/or disseminate such Intellectual Property for its benefit or the benefit of any third party. However, the Department of Nutraceuticals will be duly acknowledged for their contribution.

ARTICLE III: GENERAL TERMS

- 1. This MOU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.
- Nothing in this MOU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the parties unless expressly stated in this agreement.

- 3. This MOU may also involve parties by mutual consent, which may be added later by written addendum to this MOU.
- 4. The activities of this MOU must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in India.

ARTICLE IV: DURATION

1. This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature or till completion of course, with the understanding that it may be terminated by the other parties by providing Thirty (30) days' advance written notice to the other.

ARTICLE V: CONFIDENTIALITY

- During and from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- 2. The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information:
 - is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
 - is already known or become known to the receiving party.
 - is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party,
 - is independently developed by the receiving party or
 - is required to be disclosed by law or court order.

ARTICLE VI: NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries, and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, either party may intimate the other party of such collaborations/agreements.

ARTICLE VII: RELATIONSHIP

In case of any Intellectual Property (except the Copyrights) being developed during the project then the student shall assign the Intellectual Property to ENPL.

ARTICLE IX: ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

ARTICLE X: AMENDMENTS

Amendments or changes to this agreement or MOU shall be made in writing and signed by the duly authorized Representatives.
