MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai, having the objective to provide the best quality education that exposes students to the theory and legal doctrine and provides practical skills to which create excellent professionals to serve our nation and for the matters connected there with or incidental thereto.

Whereas Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai is in mandate to establish academic integration and collaboration with such other like minded organization in the country for mutual development; and whereas Foundation for Skill Development is one of its kind and also seeks to engage in the institutional collaborations for symbiotic development, through this Memorandum of Understanding.

SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed between the Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) Mumbai as First Party and Foundation for Skill Development (FSD) as Second Party for the purpose of Academic Collaboration that will encompass exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other academic activities, research and outreach. In addition to this active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research and internship programmes that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. Some of the collaborative areas include the following:

I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION:

1. Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai and Foundation for Skill Development shall collaborate in mutually agreeable and exchange academic events, teaching, training and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms and conditions specifically agreed for each of the collaborative efforts;

2. Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai and Foundation for Skill Development shall exchange reading and study material and jointly conduct events to bring the best practices of Law Industry and Students of Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai.

3. Foundation for Skill Development shall provide its members the opportunities to be visiting faculty for important academic events viz., P. G. Diploma Courses, Certificate Courses, Seminars, Conferences, Outreach activities and for special teaching at Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous), Mumbai. Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) Mumbai students shall get internship opportunities with Foundation for Skill Development Members.

II. AREAS OF COOPERATION:

This Memorandum expresses the common intention of Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) Mumbai and Foundation for Skill Development to collaborate in furtherance of such of the above common intentions defined towards catering to a mutual academic and intellectual climate and enhance the legal understanding capacity and scholarship of Guru Nanak Khalsa College (Autonomous) Mumbai students and staff. Additional areas of co-operation may be appended by written consent of both the parties. Both parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum are realized.

III. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by giving 60 days written notice to the other. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects

established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum.

IV. REVENUE WORKING MODEL

The Revenue model, if any shall be decided between the parties and the same will be notified in advance before the commencement of the course.

V. NON-BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic and legal collaboration.

VI. TERMINATION

1. This memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.
2. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of Three years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of sixty days and without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any of the students of either institution.
