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SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION – I

WHY IS ₹25 BEING COLLECTED?

Swami Vivekanand Yuva Suraksha Yojana – A.Y. 2026–27

The College has been providing insurance protection to students through the conventional student insurance arrangement and has already recovered **₹50/- per student towards insurance** as part of the regular College fees.

For A.Y. 2026–27, however, the College is required to implement the **Swami Vivekanand Yuva Suraksha Yojana** under the Government/University framework.

The Scheme originates from the **Government of Maharashtra, Higher & Technical Education Department GR No. संकीर्ण-2021/प्र.क्र.14/विशि-5 dated 16 October 2023**, subsequently named *Swami Vivekanand Yuva Suraksha Yojana* vide GR dated **28 November 2023**.

Further, **University of Mumbai Circular No. 7/2026 dated 22 May 2026** has directed affiliated colleges to implement the Scheme during A.Y. 2026–27. The Nodal Agency, Directorate of Higher Education, has also specifically communicated to the College that implementation for **A.Y. 2026–27 is Mandatory**.

WHAT IS SPECIAL ABOUT THE NEW INSURANCE? An important feature of the prescribed Personal Accident Insurance is that the protection extends beyond the student:

1 STUDENT + 1 DECLARED PARENT / GUARDIAN

The policy also contains other specified accident-related benefits, subject to its terms and conditions.

HOW IS THE ₹25 ARRIVED AT? As communicated by the Nodal Agency:

National Insurance Co. Ltd. : Base Premium ₹62.00

+ GST @ 18% ₹11.16

= Annual Premium ₹73.16 per student

The College has **already recovered ₹50/- towards Student Insurance**.

Therefore, only the **additional insurance contribution of ₹25/-(Rounded figure)** is presently being collected from students towards implementation of the revised Government-prescribed insurance arrangement. **WHO HAS TO PAY ₹25?**

ALL FY + SY + TY Degree (UG) Students

Aided as well as Unaided

The objective is to ensure **continuity as well as enhanced insurance protection for students under the Government-prescribed framework**.

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SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION – II
CAREER KATTA – A.Y. 2026–27

Why are SY & TY Students required to pay ₹365/-?

The College has decided to implement the **Career Katta initiative** for the benefit of students during A.Y. 2026–27.

Career Katta is an initiative under the **Higher & Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra**, aimed at providing students with opportunities and support relating to **career development, employability, competitive examinations, entrepreneurship and related career-oriented activities.**

WHY IS A SEPARATE ₹365 BEING COLLECTED FROM SY & TY?

There is a simple administrative reason. Admissions of most **Second Year (SY) and Third Year (TY)** students for A.Y. 2026–27 had already been substantially completed **during April 2026**. The College subsequently decided to implement the **Career Katta initiative in May 2026**. Therefore: **FY (UG) Students**

→ Career Katta component could be incorporated into their **regular admission fee structure**.

SY & TY UG Students

→ Their admission/fee process had already taken place earlier.

→ Hence, the **₹365 Career Katta component could not be included in their regular fees at that stage**.

Accordingly, to enable **SY and TY students also to avail themselves of the benefits of the Career Katta initiative**, the applicable **₹365/- for A.Y. 2026–27 is now required to be deposited separately**.

IMPORTANT

The separate collection of ₹365 from SY/TY students is **not a duplication of fees**. It arises because the Career Katta initiative was adopted after their regular admission/fee process had substantially been completed. The College is extending the initiative to **SY and TY students so that they too can receive its career-oriented benefits during A.Y. 2026–27**.

Students are therefore requested to **cooperate and make the applicable payment strictly as per the schedule displayed on Page 1**.
