- Name of student / department /guide not to be disclosed on the poster.
- The poster can have colorful, relevant pictures/photographs.
- The poster may state the Objective, Materials and Methods, Observations, Results, Conclusion, References etc.
- Participants are requested to display their posters in the College Hall on allocated space by 8.30 am on 28th February 2026, Saturday.
- Per poster maximum 2 participants allowed.
- Participants are requested to carry stationary required for hanging of poster.
- Online: The physical poster as per above guidelines, should reach GNIRD latest by 25.02.2026. The poster will be put up at the venue by volunteers. Date and time for online presentation of the poster will be intimated later.
