- Participants: 20-30 students per session.
- Duration of the activity – 1.5 hr per session i.e. 4.5 hrs for all the three sessions

Campus Clean-up and Waste Awareness Initiative: Students will engage in a campus clean-up, collecting and segregating waste. They will also create posters on waste management, which will be displayed near bins to promote proper disposal and sustainability.

- Participants: 20-30 students per drive.
- Duration of the activity – 2 hrs

Beach Clean-up drives: Students will be participating in the beach clean-up drive activity organised by UWM. All the safety tools like Gloves, Mask, waste collection bags will be provided by UWM.

- Participants: 20-30 students per drive
- Duration of the activity – 2 hrs

Shore walk Activity: Students will participate in the shore-walk activity where marine expert from UWM, will explain different species found at the shores of Mumbai.

- Participants: 20-25 students per drive
- Duration of the activity – 2 hrs

Art-competition: Students will participate in the art competition such as model making, best out of waste, drawing etc.

- Participants: 20-25 students
- Duration of the activity – 3 hrs

Project Duration: September 24 to March 25

To participate in these activities Guru Nanak Khalsa College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomus) would require

- Minimum 25 students to allocate a minimum of 2 hours per month till the project period for all the above mentioned activities.
- Target age group: 18 years to 25 years
- Active Engagement of Teacher- A minimum of one teacher will be actively engaged during all the activities and should also document the activity carried out during the month.

United Way Mumbai will be responsible

- To conduct all the awareness sessions, workshops, expert lectures and other activities mentioned above.
- To provide certificate of participation to all the students who participate in the activities under this project.
- To do the arrangements of refreshment and conveyance to student as and when applicable.
